## At a Glance

**Who We Are:** The Danforth Gallery is a non-profit art gallery in Livingston, Montana. It is operated by Park County Friends of the Arts (PCFA), a §501(c)(3) community non-profit organization founded in 1974.

**Mission:** To nurture the creation and awareness of art by providing opportunities for contemporary artists and by offering innovative outreach programs, so that our community—especially our youth—can realize the importance of art in their lives.

**Our Exhibitions and Programs:** Each year, the Danforth offers innovative and exciting exhibitions and programs. Our exhibition season begins in spring and runs into the fall. Six or more exhibitions of new and established artists from Montana and nationwide are offered each year—the summer exhibitions' openings coincide with Livingston's Art Walk (the fourth Friday of each month). During the winter months, we offer exciting programs that include educational themes (lectures and classes); films; lecture and contests. Our recent program series, Art Attack on Tuesdays, was a great success.

**Membership:** Many of our exhibitions and programs are made possible by the generosity of our members, who come from the community and across the country. Members are entitled to previews of exhibitions and to discounts on purchases made in *The Back Room*. Membership is annual.

**About the Building:** Built circa 1903, the Danforth Gallery is located at 106 North Main Street in Livingston. It has been the home to the Gallery since 1974. In 1996, the building was granted to PCFA by John and Diane Stillman, longtime benefactors to the organization. The first floor contains the Gallery's main exhibition space and *The Back Room*, a retail space operated by the Gallery. The second floor is reserved for artist studios. Local artists Edd Enders and Brad Bunkers lease space from PCFA.

**Governance:** Park County Friends of the Arts is governed by a board of directors, including four officers. There is also an advisory board. It has two paid employees: a Gallery Director and one staff member.
